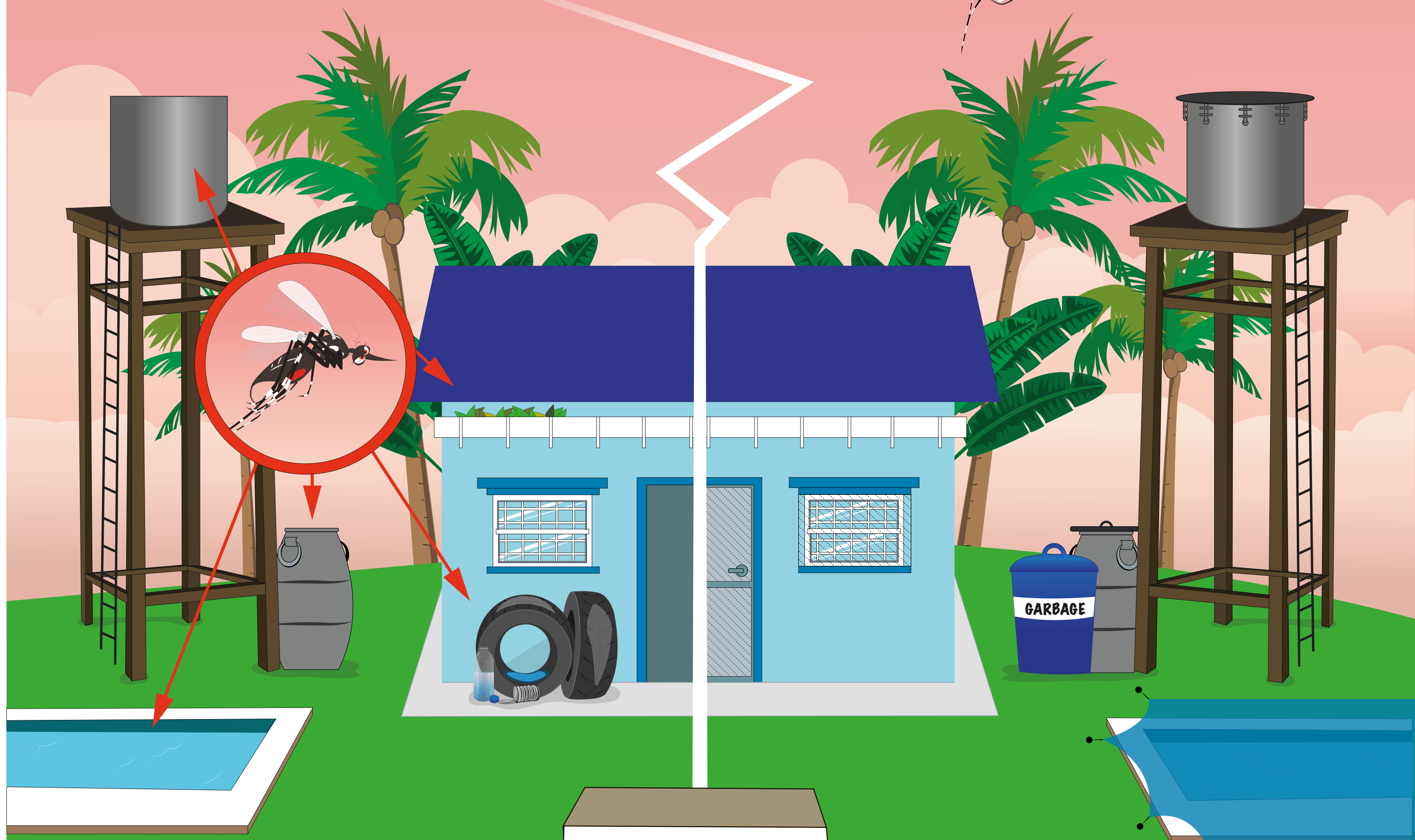

DESTROY MOSQUITO BREEDING SITES

- 1 CHANGE** WATER IN VASES AND FLOWER POTS ONCE A WEEK. IT IS IMPORTANT TO CLEAN THEM IN CASE MOSQUITO EGGS ARE ATTACHED TO THE SIDES.
- 2 BRUSH** THE SIDES OF BARRELS, AT LEAST ONCE A WEEK.
- 3 COVER** TANKS, SINKS, AND POOLS. **PROTECT** DOORS AND WINDOWS WITH MOSQUITO NETTING.
- 4 TURN OVER** CONTAINERS THAT CAN ACCUMULATE WATER AND REMOVE ANY THAT ARE NOT NECESSARY.
- 5 KEEP** GARBAGE CONTAINERS DRY AND WELL COVERED.
- 6 CLEAN RAIN GUTTERS AND DRAINS**, IF THEY GET BLOCKED WITH LEAVES AND GARBAGE, THERE WILL BE MOSQUITOES.
- 7 SHARE** INFORMATION AND HELP YOUR NEIGHBORS: IF THEY HAVE BREEDING SITES, THE ENTIRE NEIGHBORHOOD WILL HAVE MOSQUITOES.
